

Instructions to Send a Free Book to Your Kindle

Note: If an author emails a Kindle Version (mobi) copy of a book directly to your email, then you will want to forward that email with the attached mobi copy of the book to whatever email address you use for your Amazon account (if the email you used to sign up for the author's mailing list is different). If the email address where you received the free copy of the book is the same as your email for Amazon, then you can skip to the instructions on How to Find Your Kindle's Email Address

Here are instructions on how to get a book from Bookfunnel. More and more authors are using this as a method to distribute free books, so hopefully this will be useful to you:

How to Get a Free Book from Bookfunnel:

1. Click on the link the author provided. You will be brought to the book's Bookfunnel page. You should see the cover of the book and the book's description.
2. Click on the big blue bottom that says Get My Book:




3. A screen will pop up that will give you the below options:

What do you like to read on?



- Since you want to get it on your Kindle, click the Kindle Tablet or E-Reader button. You will once again be given a list of several options. The easiest option is to click the bottom Email My Book option:




This screenshot shows four selection options for Kindle devices, each with a small image of the device and a description:

- Another screen will pop up. You will want to pick the Mobi option. Then, in the email box, type in the email that you use to sign in to your Amazon account (the one that you use to buy Kindle books).

6. Once you have your email address typed in, click the Send Book button. Once you've done that, you will see the below confirmation (with your email in the place I've blanked my own email out with blue).

You should receive it within five minutes. If you don't see it, check your junk folder or Promotions tab for a message from help@bookfunnel.com.

Still can't find it? Email help@bookfunnel.com with the subject *whitelist* to add us to your address book and then try sending again.

7. This will email a mobi (Kindle version) of the free book to whatever email address you typed in. You can now exit Bookfunnel and go to your email.
8. In your email, locate the email from Bookfunnel. It should look something like this:

9. You have now gotten the copy of the Free Book from Bookfunnel.

How to Find Your Kindle's Email Address

Note: Each Kindle has its own email address. This is DIFFERENT than the email address that you use to sign into Amazon. If you don't know your Kindle's email address, then here is how you find it.


1. Sign into Amazon
2. Once in Amazon, go to Your Account by clicking on the bottom in the top right hand corner that says, Hello, [Your Name]




3. This will bring you to a new screen with a lot of options. The middle set of options should be Digital Content and Devices. Click on the first option: Manage content and devices.



4. This will open a screen that lists all your digital content, including Kindle books, movies, music, etc. At the top of the screen, you should see that it is currently on the Content tab. Click on the Devices Tab.




5. This will open a screen that shows you all the devices that you have linked to this Amazon account, including Amazon TVs, Fire sticks, tablets, and your Kindle. Click on the Kindle option.



6. This will drop down a menu showing all of your Kindles on this Amazon account. Click on the blue link for your particular Kindle.

7. This will open a screen that will show you all the details about your Kindle. The top item will be your Kindle's specific email address:

8. Write this email address down and save it in a place you'll remember it. You'll need to know this email address whenever you send a Free Book to your Kindle. I would recommend setting this Kindle email address as a contact in whatever email you use to sign into Amazon. That way, whenever you want to send a book to your Kindle, this Kindle email address is already saved.
9. Congratulations! You now know your Kindle's Email Address! You can now send your free book to your Kindle!

How to Send Your Free Book to Your Kindle

Note: You have to send your free book to your Kindle from the email address you use to sign into your Amazon account. This is the **ONLY** email address that Amazon will recognize as safe to send documents to your Kindle. There is a way to tell Amazon that another email address is safe, but, for now, let's stick with using the email address that you use for Amazon.

1. Open your email inbox and locate your email from Bookfunnel, from the author, or from yourself (depending on how you received your free book).
2. Forward this email (with the attached Kindle version of the book) to your Kindle's specific email address (which you just located).
3. You will have to wait a few minutes. Then you should receive an email from Amazon asking you to verify that you sent a document to your Kindle. This is another safety measure on Amazon's part:

4. Open the email and click on the blue link that says Verify Request:

5. You should receive confirmation that your request has been verified:

6. Your Free Book will now download on your Kindle automatically just like any other Kindle book.
